Lani-Kailua Outdoor Circle seeks t-shirt design
for 2018 I Love Kailua Town Party – our 25th year!!!

The Lani-Kailua Outdoor Circle announces its search for a design for a t-shirt to be sold at the 25th annual I Love Kailua Town Party, to be held on April 29, 2018. The Town Party is a street fair open to the public with food, craft, and art booths, keiki activities, etc.

The mission of the Lani-Kailua Outdoor Circle is to keep Kailua Clean, Green, and Beautiful and to that end, LKOC has, for the past 24 years, organized the annual I Love Kailua Town Party, a fundraiser for Kailua beautification projects, such as Kalapawai Triangle Park, Pali Palms triangle, and other landscaping and tree planting projects throughout our town.

The t-shirt design contest this year is open to all Windward artists, and we are

seeking original art (no photographs, please) that best represents the special place that is Kailua. We are looking for bright colors, and perhaps a whimsical note, that will show the special place that is Kailua and will translate into the silk screen process used for printing the t-shirts and the entry buttons.

This is a great opportunity to get your art seen by the more than 5,000 people attending the Town Party and featured in the publicity seen by thousands of others.

Credit for the selected design is of course given, the artist is introduced at the Party, and the design is featured in publicity for the Town Party, as well as becoming the logo and t-shirt design sold by the Lani-Kailua Outdoor Circle.

- Artwork must be original. NO PHOTOS PLEASE.
- Design must be suitable for the silk screen process used to transfer the design to t-shirts.
- Design should be at least 5" x 7"

The winner of the selected design will receive an honorarium of \$100. The publicity is priceless. The artwork becomes the property of the Lani-Kailua Outdoor Circle for one year, after which time the artwork may be returned to the artist. LKOC reserves the right to modify or change the artwork as deemed suitable for the silk screen process.

Deadline for submission of artwork is November 12, 2017. Selection will be made by December 1, 2016 and the honorarium of \$100 will be paid at that time.

Please include your full name, address, and phone number with your art, so that we may contact you. If you want your art returned, please include a stamped, self addressed envelope.
