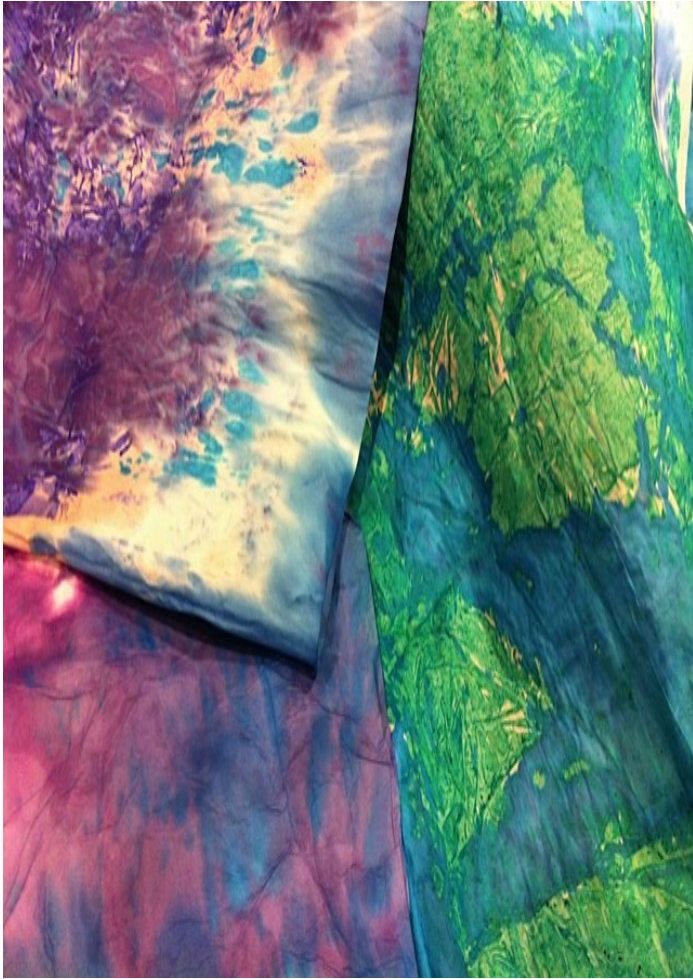


Paper Dyeing & Collage Workshops

- **Sat - Mon February 17 - 19**
9:30 am - 2:30 pm for creating collage projects with the dyed papers.



All days will take place at Ho'omaluhia Botanical Gardens at the Visitor Center Workshop in Kaneohe on Luluku Road

The price will be \$115.00 for the paper dyeing workshop. This includes all papers (you will take home at least 100 dyed papers), and dyes. The price for the collage project workshops will be \$45.00 for each workshop. If you choose to do all 4 workshops the price will be \$200.00

Collaging with Hand Dyed Papers

WORKSHOP SUPPLY LIST

FOR PAPER DYEING DAY:

- A pair or two of HEAVY DUTY plastic or vinyl gloves (not the type used to wash dishes)
- Wear old clothes, an apron, and covered shoes.

FOR WORKSHOP DAYS:

- Two 18" x 24" canvases (stretched or canvas board).
- One Lampshade
- Hardware store bristle brushes in 1" and 2" sizes for gluing down the papers.
- Several glass jars with tight lids, small to medium size.
- An exacto knife...the small ones with metal (silver colored) handles and an angled blade work the best.
- Watercolors with a brush & palette (buy a pan of inexpensive watercolors if you do not have. Do not buy the washable type!)
- Sponges, paper towels, 2 plastic containers for water, plastic garbage bags for trash.

FOR ALL DAYS:

- Bring a notebook and pen to jot notes in.
- Bring a pot luck dish and something to drink. (We have been doing pot luck lunches and it's fun!)
- Wear old clothes and a good-sized apron as this fun medium can be messy!

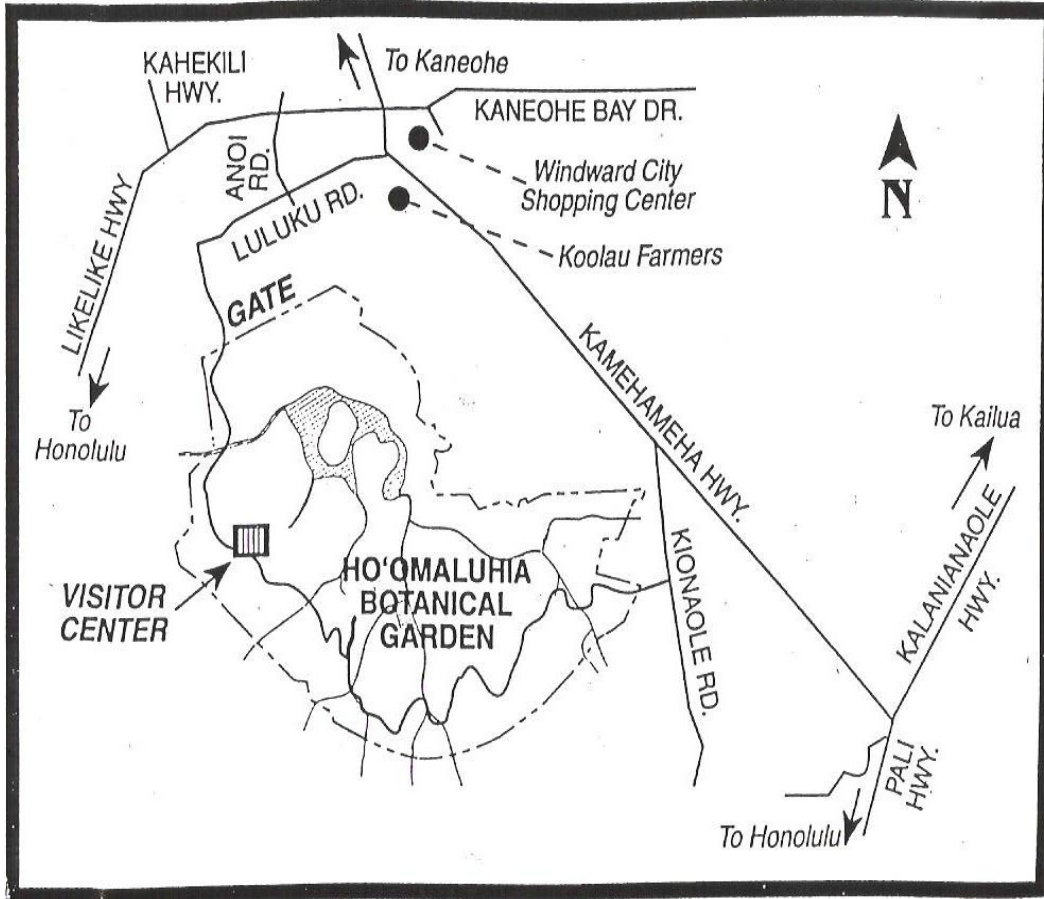
THE SRA Gals WILL PROVIDE:

- All dyes
- All papers: Expect at least 100 dyed tissues & newsprint. You will be taking wet papers home to dry before we begin work on a collage, and you will have a week to dry & prepare your papers.
- All glues for use during the workshop
- ABOUT COLLAGING pass outs.
