Liz Haywood-Sullivan, Juror

What do you value most in an art teacher? Is it the ability to know when to challenge and when to support? Is it the ability to encourage you to the greatest extent of your ability? Liz Haywood-Sullivan, PSA-MP, IAPS/MC, has been described as workshop leader skilled in the capacities to elevate her students to be the best artist they can be. She is a representational landscape artist painting in the pastel medium. Her award-winning paintings are defined by strong contrasts and color, dramatic lighting, and graphic compositions, which often feature the interplay between man and the environment.

Haywood-Sullivan is an outstanding, nationally acclaimed artist, and an equally outstanding, comprehensive, methodical instructor. Her workshop participants have said they were challenged and inspired to try never-before used techniques, to elevate their knowledge and technique to a more advanced level. Her ability to adapt her workshop to suit the specific needs of the group. Her style of teaching has been called thoughtful and intuitive but most of all generous. "To share your wealth of knowledge so readily, speaks volumes," according to one PSA member. According to another, Haywood-Sullivan is able to meet students at their level and encourage and challenge them at the same time.

ELIGIBILITY AND FEES: This show is open to all artists. \$12 per painting for members; \$15 per painting for non-members. Each artist may submit up to six entries. A 20-percent commission will be applied to all works sold. SPECIFICATIONS: All works must be in 80% or more soft pastel medium (includes NuPastels). No oil pastels will be accepted. All work must be original – conceived and created independently by the entrant within the last two years. Work that was previously accepted in any juried exhibition in Hawai'i, created in a class or workshop, or copied from public material is not eligible. Acceptance of unusual entries shall be at the juror's discretion.

FRAMING AND MATTING: Mats and frames should be simple. All mats must be neatly cut, clean and light to mid-value, neutral, muted in color. A colored Inner mat or liner, no wider than ¼" is acceptable. If no mat is used, a spacer should be used to separate the painting from the glass or Plexiglas. The frame itself must not be overly wide or ornate to give an impression similar to a colored mat or detract from the painting.

Frames must be undamaged and wired for hanging. No sawtooth hangers, nails, gallery clips or protruding screw-eye hooks will be accepted. Regular, UV, Image Perfect, Conservation and Museum glass, and Plexiglas are acceptable. Non-glare glass or non-glare Plexiglas will not be accepted. Paintings delivered in a chipped, cracked, damaged, or dirty condition, or in an otherwise unprofessional presentation will not be accepted and will be returned at the artist's expense. Caution must be taken to ensure that the submitted paintings are not overly heavy. Neither PAH nor KCC is responsible for any damage to any work hung during the course of the show.

SUBMISSIONS: All entries and fees must be received by PAH no later than September 24, 2018. Digital images of your paintings can be submitted either online at <https://www.pastelartistsofhawaii.com/showentry> or by mailing your images on a flash drive to the showchair (see below).

SUBMISSION BY FLASH DRIVE (No CDs please): Mail your flash drive in a padded envelope, along with the completed entry forms, fees and a self-addressed, stamped envelope to **PAH, Showchair**, .8033 Kamehameha V Hwy, Kaunakakai, HI. 96748 Artists may pick up their flash drives on entry day. Please mail flash drive early enough to be RECEIVED by September 20th.

ONLINE SUBMISSION: Go online to PAH, <https://www.pastelartistsofhawaii.com/showentry> and follow the instructions. All entrants, whether they are current members of PAH, must have a username and password. If you do not have one, you will be asked to create one. All entrants must agree to the liability waiver by checking the agreement box. Once you have done so, you may enter your paintings online. You should have the following information: 1) painting title, 2) viewable dimensions WxH in inches, 3) painting price, and 4) jpeg of painting.

You may return to the site to upload more paintings or change any information on the paintings you uploaded at any time up to the September 24th deadline date. All entries will remain in a pending status until your entry fees are received by PAH either by online payment or mailed check. If mailing a check, please write in the lower left corner that you submitted your paintings online.

DIGITAL PHOTO FORMAT: Each image should be saved at least 72dpi, no more than 1170 pixels in its largest dimension and no greater than 2MB in file size. Larger files cannot be accepted. Each image file must be saved as a BASELINE (not "progressive") JPEG. Please name your files using the format designated on the Entry Thingy website. You will be able to add them in the title online or on your entry form.

ACCEPTANCE NOTIFICATION: Barring any unforeseen event, acceptance notification will be emailed out by October 1st. Please note that acceptance is by initial screening only. It is up to the juror, when she sees the actual painting in place, to determine whether the painting will be in the show. A catalogue fee of \$10 per artist will be assessed upon acceptance and due when you bring your paintings on Hanging Day.

ARTISTS' BIO Artists with paintings in the show are requested to provide PAH with a brief bio along with a photo and website to share with patrons who are interested in purchasing paintings. These will be available in a binder at the show. If you do not have your own website, you can create a free site at www.wix.com. Also please bring in a portfolio of originals and/or reprints, matted in cellophane for patrons to view and purchase.

SHIPPED PAINTINGS: All shipped paintings must arrive at the home of Roger and Barbara Tinius by October 29, 2018, and must be shipped in sturdy, reshippable boxes with paid return shipment labels, or a check made to PAH for the amount of return shipping. SHOW HANGING DAY: Saturday, November 3, 9-11am at Kapʻolani CC, Lama Library Gallery. Bring your accepted paintings ready to hang with ID TAGS securely attached to the backside lower left corner of the painting (as seen from the back).

LIABILITY: All possible care will be taken in handling and displaying each entry. However, neither Pastel Artists of Hawaiʻi nor KCC, nor any other receiving agent will be responsible for any loss or damage to any work submitted for the exhibition. Each entrant must assume all responsibility for any loss or damage to any of their work, and should carry their own insurance during the show. All entrants are required to sign a liability waiver for their entries. PAH is also not liable for paintings not picked up during the designated times. These paintings will be left at Place, or an alternate location, for pickup by the artist.
