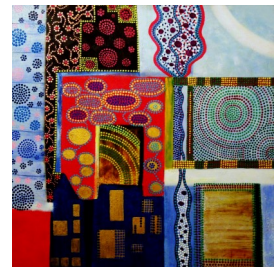

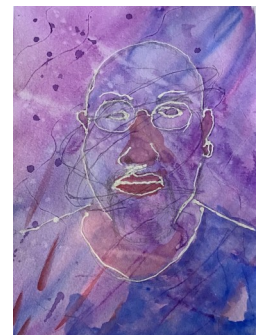
### Congratulations to . . .

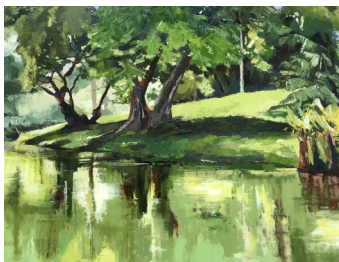

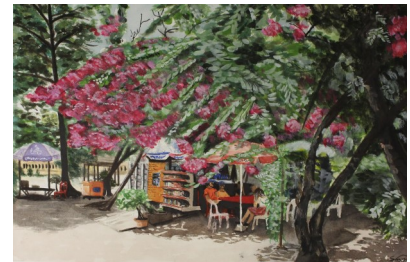
#### Hawaii Regional Scholastic Art Awards
