Materials you need to bring for painting:

- Pen and paper
- Painting materials (paints, brushes, water containers, clean-up materials, other items that you use)
- Two (2) supports to paint on (canvas, canvas panel, prepared paper, etc.) Minimum size is 16" x 20".
- Table easel (if you have)

Other materials to bring:

- Your lunch/beverages (please note there is no refrigeration available and no options for food or beverage purchase.)
- We will be working outside for part of the workshop, but not painting outside. Consider bringing sunscreen, hat, bug spray, small chair or stool. Our indoor work will be in the large workshop room. Signs will be posted.
